



A reading from the Gospel according to Matthew

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. And for those who look after them.

In faith we pray: We pray to you, Lord God.

Fr Paul blesses the Christingles, which are then distributed and then we sing:
